



The stained glass windows were designed and made by [Isobel Ackary](#) of Horam and incorporate ancient symbols for the Trinity into a modern design with each window having a Trinitarian theme.

Looking from the inside of the church:

- The left hand window is dedicated to God the Father, represented by God's hand reaching down to earth blessing and supporting mankind.
- The right hand window is dedicated to God the Son, represented by the sign of the fish (the oldest symbol of the Christian church) and the water of life flowing down from heaven.
- The central window is dedicated to God the Holy Spirit, represented by the dove coming down from heaven bringing God's peace and love to mankind.
